Veteran's Day Parade Review

It was a crisp morning on November 14, as 33 from Central gathered to walk in the Veteran's Day Parade. We were there early and ready to walk. We had two beautiful, white trucks (Kevin Stanley's and Shane Abernathy's) as our parade "floats". Both were decorated with red, white and blue fringe. Aboard our "float" trucks were some of our fine Central Veterans: Mark Foshee, John Hayes, Kevin Stanley. And special guest was Bobby King's dad, Mr. Robert King. He was in the Philippines, during WW2, from 1943 - 1945. Thank you to Mr. King and to all our Veterans.

We proudly displayed the five flags of our U.S. military: Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines and Coast Guard. We had two large banners that were back to back on one pole, that was 11 feet long that said, "Thank Veteran's for you service". Thank you to Suzanne Stanley for arranging one banner to be made by the elementary Bible School department. The other banner was made by our Activity CARE group, who started this parade walking effort in the first place. (It was Tony Coley's idea, and it was a good one). A third banner was designed by Bob Miller. Thank you, Bob, for getting it done for us. It was great.

It has been a long time since I was in a parade. I think, the last time was in Boy Scouts in New Egypt, New Jersey on Memorial Day in the early 1960's. I had fun then and we had fun this past Saturday. Last Saturday, I rode around on my WW2 replica bicycle with a long PVC pole attached. At the top of the pole my dad's U.S. flag flapping in the wind. He flew a U.S. Flag on a tall pole in our front yard in Fruitland, Tennessee. That's the flag I flew on my bike. I intended it as a reminder of why we were there last Saturday...our U. S. Military VETERANS! And why do we have the right to be in a parade? Our U. S. Military Veterans and active Military! Thank you to the Men and Women who were or who are serving in the military.
