Strengthening the Soul...

"I am the way and the truth and the life..." Jesus

Jesus was constantly inviting His first followers to follow Him by not only believing that His words were Truth - but by understanding that following Him was the only Truth-full Way to live Life. Have you ever read the Gospels and pondered HOW Jesus lived His life? Have you ever noticed WHAT He did and the WAY He did it and HOW OFTEN He did it and WITH WHOM He did it? If you allow those questions to frame your study of the Life of Jesus - I think you will begin to notice that Jesus lived a particular LIFESTYLE. And I



have begun to see that the Lifestyle of Jesus as seen in the Gospels can best be characterized as a Lifestyle of Holy Rhythm.

When you read about the Life of Jesus – do you ever see Jesus running around frantic and in a hurry? In a word – NO! Jesus – increasingly surrounded with crowds of needy people and spiritually carrying the weight of mankind toward a Cross in Jerusalem maintained a distinctive lifestyle of strategic RHYTHM. Check me out on this, but I will suggest that the RHYTHM of Jesus' life is both RECOGNIZABLE and REPLICABLE. You and I can read and ponder His life in the Gospels and SEE this lifestyle of **RHYTHM** and if we desire, can begin to let Him show us how to live with the same *HOLY RHYTHM*.

Here is what I have noticed about the Holy Rhythm of Jesus' life:

- Regular and Consistent Daily SOLITUDE Being With God Mark 1:35 Jesus required daily time alone with God to pray and abide in soul- nourishing intimacy with His Father. (Take-Away: Do I daily have a time when I "disconnect" from the demands of life - and fellowship with the Father of Life?)
- Regular Cultivation of COMMUNITY Being With God With Others Mark 3:13-14 Jesus called a small group of folks to be with Him, to live life together and to nourish one another on the journey of Life. (Take-Away: Do I have a small group of family, friends, brothers & sisters with whom I "do life together"?)
- Regular Practice of DOING GOOD Being With God for the Sake of Others Acts 10:38 Jesus invested His life in ministry to others - teaching, preaching, healing, serving, and loving. (Take-Away: Do I see my job/work as a way to use my God-given talents to help and serve others and "go about doing good"?)

I pray you are walking in RHYTHM with Jesus today!


HELP NEEDED
