# **JESUS' EASTER**

Easter came early this year. I am always confused about when to plant tomatoes when Easter comes in March. Although it is warming up and the trees are budding out, it still seems too early to plant summer food crops. I guess I'll have to consult the *Old Farmer's Almanac*. Easter came early and I wasn't here to celebrate with you. I appreciate the opportunity to be at the Lads to Leaders convention last weekend. A good time was had by all, I believe. However, it is good to be back here with you. I also appreciate Ross and Steve for filling in for me; I know they did a great job speaking.



Since I wasn't here on Easter Sunday I am taking this Sunday as an opportunity to talk about a sermon Jesus preached whose script is really lost to us. For some reason the Holy Spirit didn't see fit to tell us Jesus' words like he did in the Sermon on the Mount. The sermon to which I am referring is the one on the road to Emmaus in Luke 24. I have always been fascinated by the sermon Jesus preached to the two disciples on the road to Emmaus. The text simply states that Jesus expounded all that Moses and all the prophets had to say about Messiah. This, of course, was the resurrected Christ appearing as a traveler on the road with those two disciples. This is why I refer to this as Jesus' Easter Sermon because it was delivered on the day the tomb was found empty.

As I reflected back on this passage earlier last week in our preacher's meeting I noticed the appeal to the Scriptures. The text refers to "the Scriptures" three different times: in verse 27 that Jesus expounded upon the Scriptures, in verse 32 the disciples concurred that Jesus had "opened the Scriptures" and in verse 45 that Jesus had opened their understanding that they might comprehend the Scriptures. These three occurrences signal, to me at least, that the resurrected Christ's main concern for His disciples after the resurrection was that they be taught the Scriptures and that they have a thorough understanding of the Scriptures. This Sunday morning, we will explore these three references in more detail.
