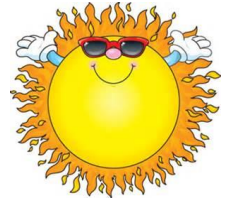

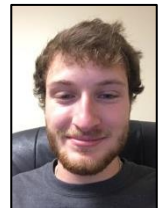
SUMMER YOUTH INTERNS
