Brad Harrub Ph.D. is the Executive Director and co-founder of Focus Press plus a speaker and author of topics such as Biblical truths and ethics. He is also Executive Editor of Think magazine, a monthly magazine about current issues from a distinctly Christian view. He is a popular speaker on Christian evidences at lectureships and youth rallies in over 47 states and five different continents. Dr. Harrub serves as an adjunct faculty member at the Bear Valley Bible Institute in Denver. Originally from Franklin, Tennessee, Brad Harrub holds an earned B.S. degree in biology from Kentucky Wesleyan College and an earned doctorate degree in anatomy and neurobiology from the College of Medicine at the University of Tennessee in Memphis. Dr. Harrub has authored or co-authored numerous scientific publications in science journals and written numerous books and countless articles on both Biblical and science topics. Additionally, he has produced several DVD's and Audio CD's covering various topics. He and his wife, Melinda, attend the Southern Hills Church of Christ in Franklin, Tennessee & have four children: Will, Reese, Claire, and Luke
