It's Never too Late to Turn Around!



A few weeks ago, I was planning on driving from Cleveland, Ga to our cabin on the Toccoa River in Blue Ridge. The road that I would travel is the most winding & undulating road I've ever driven. It is a great road to drive alone but not with any passengers; they all get car sick. During my time in college in Dahlonega, I made this drive literally over 100 times. I knew it "like the back of my hand". But this trip was different....

During this drive, my mind was pre-occupied. Ben was scheduled to have his MRI in a few days and I was thinking about what he was facing instead of the road I was on. In order for me to successfully reach the cabin, the river must always remain on my left; I should NEVER cross the river!!! I was appx. 3 miles from the cabin and I did something I knew I shouldn't do, I turned left and CROSSED THE RIVER. I knew it was a mistake and I knew I should've turned around

but I didn't. Whether I was too comfortable with the road or just too stubborn to admit I made a mistake, I refused to turn around. I stayed on the same road (the one I knew I shouldn't be on) for 20+ miles. It eventually dumped me out on the other side of Ellijay (appx. 25 miles past the cabin).

I am so thankful that we serve a God who not only allows but encourages us to "Turn-Around" when we've gone astray. As I look at the life of David, his story is full of examples of "making a wrong turn" or "going down a road he shouldn't have". How is your daily "road" with God? It is so easy to be too comfortable with the road we're on to notice we need to make a change. I encourage you to not make the same mistake I did. We can never be so far gone that we can't "Turn-Around".
