Several times now, groups from Central have made trips to the Churches of Christ Disaster Relief Effort in Nashville, TN. Steve Barton has written our bulletin article this week to tell us a little about what happens on these trips so that maybe more will be interested in going on the next trip.

Most people don't know what goes on when we ask for volunteers to ride in our new church van to Nashville and pack boxes of food and supplies for the disasters that have happened recently. So I'm going to give you an insight. The Churches of Christ in the Tennessee Valley (including N. Georgia & N. Alabama) help support the Churches of Christ Disaster Relief Effort Inc. Located at 410 Allied Dr. in Nashville, TN. This organization helps people who are involved in any natural disasters that may occur in the U.S. When the Hurricane Harvey hit Houston, the CoC Disaster Relief Effort already had 5 truckloads full of boxes ready to send to the churches in Southeast Texas. This is where the "Central Volunteers" come in. We meet at the church building at 7 a.m. and arrive in Nashville at 10 a.m. The relief center is a big warehouse set up like an assembly line. Boxes run on the line and you place items in the box. They also have a place at the end of the line for those who need to sit down, to write cards to put in each box. Imagine 230 other people there with you doing the same thing, with the same Spirit and Love of the Lord.

- It takes 2.5 hours to pack 1500 boxes for a truck load.
- 4-5 Loads per week being shipped.
- # Loads from Nashville to Houston, TX per date 14 - 33 Loads from Nashville to South Texas per date.
- The Relief Center is currently sending loads of food to California for fire victims. (4-5 trucks per week)
- A Truck leaves Nashville on Tuesday, delivers on Saturday and returns on Tuesday. This is non-stop rotation.
- There are currently 5 truckloads on the way to Puerto Rico.

There are meals served after packing is done, or we eat on the way home. We always have fun going up to Nashville and coming home. **Come go with us on the Next trip!**

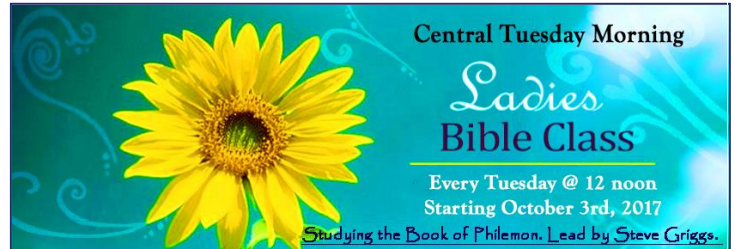
