### **Strengthening the Soul**

"Come, follow me...and I will make you fishers of men" - Matthew 4:19
"...go and make disciples of all nations..." Matthew 28:19

It seems significant to me that some of the first words of Jesus and the last words of Jesus are focused on **DISCIPLESHIP!**Jesus **CALLS** us to **BECOME** disciples and then he **COMMANDS** us to **MAKE** disciples. Simply put, being a Christian is saturated with **DISCIPLESHIP** – coming and going!

So, how is that working for you in your life today? Is your primary identity in this life that of being a disciple of Christ? Do you understand yourself and can you explain to others what being a disciple of Jesus is all about? Is it your understanding and belief that the life of being a disciple of Jesus is not for some "super Christian" who has some special gift or ability beyond the "normal" Christian experience – but that being a Christian = learning to be a disciple who then goes and makes other disciples. Do you understand and are you experiencing the reality of the daily life of discipleship to Jesus = coming to Jesus, following after Jesus, learning from Jesus, abiding in Jesus, obeying Jesus, going with Jesus to make other disciples and then together serving Jesus and watching for Jesus to return to take us to be with Him forever?

Another thing that seems significant to me is that the word "disciple" is used over 250 times in the New Testament and the word "Christian" is used only 3 times. Both words are "Biblical" and both words describe our life as the people of Jesus. But I am coming to see that the word/concept of being a disciple of Jesus gets at the heart and purpose of our relationship with Jesus and our purpose in this world. It was no accident that God sent Jesus to live in this world in a time when the experience of being a disciple was readily understood and practiced. The Biblical concept of being a disciple is pretty vague and "antiquated" to our 21st century thinking. That is why it is imperative that we look closely at the life Jesus called his original disciples to live with him and try to learn how that life of discipleship works itself out in our life and experience today. So then we can be present and have influence in our world as disciples of Jesus. So we then can say, "Hello – my name is Steve and I am a disciple of Jesus. Let me share with you the joy of following Jesus!"
