"...And such were some of you. But you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God." 1 Corinthians 6:11

And such were some of you.... Some of the Corinthian church members were involved in some of the 10 sins listed in verses 9 and 10. "Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals,^[a] nor sodomites,¹⁰ nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God." But this is no longer their lifestyle.

Washed - Acts 22:16 - "And now why are you waiting? Arise and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord." The blood of Jesus (Eph. 1:7) washes our sins away. The blood is the "soap" that washes in the water.

Sanctified - In scripture, this same Greek word for sanctified is translated holy. It means, "set apart for a special purpose".

Justified - means..."Just as if I'd" not sinned. Our sins are gone as if we never had them. Now, that is good news.

So, if something (like our souls) has been cleansed (washed) then it can be repurposed (set apart) with no trace of dirt left behind (justified). Once you get away from filth, you want to stay away from it.

In the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of God - Our baptism is the beginning point of our new relationship with our old, forgiven sins, our Savior and our Spirit. "Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit." Acts. 2:38
